Dear USNRC Representative:

This is a request to change the license governing the use of by-product materials as stipulated in our license number 06-05869-03. The current condition number 11 cannot be fulfilled for two reasons:

1. The personnel named under that condition are no longer employed by Pfizer
2. The cyclotron facility is closed (see letter of October 2, 2012) and does not produce any radioactive material to be used

It is my understanding that condition number 11 may be amended to indicate that the current RSO, Mark L. Maiello may be listed there. It is also my understanding that as an alternative to this, Pfizer may request the issuance of a decommissioning license naming Mark L. Maiello as the responsible individual.

Either is acceptable and we will of course defer to NRC. However, if the second choice has a related cost or additional effort beyond this letter, then the amendment to condition 11 is preferable because we suspect it would be the more expedient. The cyclotron is planned to be dismantled in the first half of this year using the license of our decommissioning contractor. We have confirmed with this contractor that during the decommissioning process the cyclotron would never be turned on. Therefore, a new condition 11 with Mark L. Maiello listed would suffice to meet the current status of the facility.
