Subject: Request to Withhold Information from Public Disclosure

A pre-application meeting is scheduled for January 24, 2013 between SHINE Medical Technologies, Inc. (SHINE) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to discuss the design of the SHINE production facility for seismic and external hazards.

The purpose of this letter is to request that certain portions of the SHINE presentation materials, which will be presented at the January 24, 2013 meeting to discuss the SHINE seismic and hazards analysis information, be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.

A partial presentation was sent to the NRC in SHINE letter SMT-2013-001, dated January 10, 2013. In that letter SHINE committed to provide the additional slides to complete the presentation package, which contains additional technical detail. The partial presentation and the attached material to this letter (which represents the complete presentation on the design of the SHINE production facility for seismic and external hazards) contain proprietary and security related information, and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Enclosure 1 provides the slides that will be used in the closed portion of the meeting and contain proprietary information held in confidence by SHINE. SHINE requests that the NRC withhold this information from public disclosure in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 (a)(4) and (d)(1). Enclosure 2 provides the redacted version of the closed meeting presentation slides.


Enclosure 3 contains an appropriate affidavit supporting proprietary treatment of the SHINE confidential proprietary information pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390.
