ORDER

(Directing Friends of the Earth and the NRC Staff to File Expedited Answers to SCE's Motion for Sanctions)

On November 8, 2012, the Commission in CLI-12-20 referred to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel a portion of Friends of the Earth's June 18, 2012 intervention petition challenging a Confirmatory Action Letter (CAL) issued by the NRC to Southern California Edison Company (SCE) on March 27, 2012. <u>See</u> CLI-12-20, slip op. at 5.

On December 3, 2012, this Licensing Board held a conference call¹ to discuss the procedural path forward, and on December 7, 2012, we issued an Order² that, <u>inter alia</u>, directed SCE, in coordination with Friends of the Earth, to submit a proposed Protective Order and Non-Disclosure Agreement regarding certain proprietary documents that appear to be relevant to the issue of whether the CAL constitutes a de facto license amendment.³

On December 10, 2012, we granted a joint motion from SCE and Friends of the Earth for entry of a Protective Order and Non-Disclosure Agreement.⁴

On December 12, 2012, SCE transmitted the proprietary documents to Friends of the Earth and this Board after certain individuals from Friends of the Earth submitted Non-Disclosure Affidavits.⁵

In accordance with this Board's December 20, 2012 Order,⁶ Friends of the Earth submitted proprietary and redacted versions of its opening brief and affidavits on January 11, 2013.

On January 22, 2013, SCE filed a motion for sanctions against Friends of the Earth, alleging that Friends of the Earth violated the Protective Order by inappropriately including proprietary information in a redacted version of one its affidavits. SCE requests that the Board (1) strike all protected information from Friends of the Earth's documents, (2) require all individuals that signed Non-Disclosure Affidavits to return or destroy all protected information, and (3) modify the Protective Order to prohibit further use of Protected Information in this

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proceeding.⁸ SCE represents that (1) Friends of the Earth opposes the motion, and (2) the NRC Staff does not oppose SCE filing the motion.⁹

In the interest of proceeding expeditiously, we direct Friends of the Earth and the NRC Staff to file their answers to SCE's January 22, 2013 motion no later than 12:00 noon Eastern Standard Time, Monday, January 28, 2013.

It is so ORDERED.
