

We are requesting a 90-day extension to revise and resubmit a Certificate of Financial Assurance and/or a Decommissioning Funding Plan for NRC license number 08-01738-02 as required by Title 10, Code of Federal Regulation Part 30.35(e)(2).

Decommissioning of use areas under our license is ongoing. We are actively pursuing a Navy (i.e., Joint) Radioactive Materials Permit under the Department of the Navy's Master Materials license that we will submit when approved to transfer control for the human use of radioactive materials at the Fort Belvoir Community Hospital. We are revising our decommissioning plan for the remaining buildings on the Forest Glen Section and Annex (i.e., Buildings 513 and 516) in Silver Spring, MD and intend to request the release of these buildings using site-specific derived concentration guideline levels (DCGLs). When these actions are complete, we will request termination of our NRC license.
