LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

Condition 12 of NRC License No. 09-31230-01 identifies Amanda Pereira as the Radiation Safety Officer.




Contrary to the above, the named Radiation Safety Officer left the company in July 2012, and as of December 18, 2012, the licensee had not requested amendment to its license to name another individual as the Radiation Safety Officer.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Section 6.3.d.8).

The licensee committed to cease the use of licensed material until another individual was named as Radiation Safety Officer. On January 16, 2013, the licensee requested an amendment to its license to name another qualified individual as the Radiation Safety Officer.

Statement of Corrective Actions

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the Inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved).
