PURPOSE: **TO DISCUSS THE NRC'S REVIEW OF THE LICENSEE'S DECOMMISSIONING PLAN (ML12248A095) AND ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES REGARDING LICENSE TERMINATION (MAIL CONTROL NOS. 579062 AND 577059)**

BACKGROUND: In a document dated January 13, 2012 (ML 12181A520), Aptuit, LLC (licensee), requested the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) amend Byproduct Material License No. 24-15595-01 to incorporate a Decommissioning Plan (DP) for Aptuit's Scientific Operations business line of the Kansas City, Missouri facility into its license. The Amendment was tracked under Mail Control No. 576804.

In a letter dated February 27, 2012 (ML 120590849), the licensee requested NRC's review and approval of a Clinical Trial Supplies (CTS) business line Final Status Survey Report (FSSR). The Amendment is being tracked under Mail Control No. 577059.

In a letter dated May 11, 2012 (ML12132A374), the NRC informed the licensee that the NRC staff had completed its acceptance review and had determined that the DP does not contain sufficient information to allow the staff to begin a detailed technical review. The Amendment being tracked under Mail Control No. 576804 was voided at that time.

On June 14th, 2012, the NRC visited the licensee's facility to discuss the NRC response letter dated May 11, 2012 and license amendment

requesting release of portions of the facilities for unrestricted use. The visit was documented in a Trip Report dated July 10, 2012 (ML12193A562).

In a letter dated July 26, 2012 (ML12209A411), the licensee submitted information associated with stating that two amendments will be used as part of the license termination and providing additional information associated with CTS Final Status Survey.

In a letter dated August 30, 2012 (ML12348A095), the licensee resubmitted a Decommissioning Plan for NRC review. The Amendment is being tracked under Mail Control No. 579062.

In a letter dated September 4, 2012 (ML12249A439), the licensee submitted additional information concerning the Decommissioning Plan.

In a letter dated September 18, 2012 (ML12263A150), the NRC acknowledged the receipt of the Decommissioning Plan.

In a letter dated November 8, 2012 (ML12314A055), the NRC informed the licensee that an initial acceptance review of the licensee's Decommissioning Plan had determined that the submission was sufficiently complete for the NRC to initiate a detailed technical review.

On January 8, 2013 (ML13008A302), the NRC issued a Federal Register Notice which provided the public an opportunity to provide comments and/or request a hearing and to petition for leave to intervene the licensee's amendment request regarding the decommissioning plan and termination of the license.

DISCUSSION:

The NRC staff discussed with the licensee NRC's review of the Decommissioning Plan (DP) dated August 30, 2012. Specifically, the NRC's discussion centered on additional questions and potential deficiencies in the licensee's DP and other decommissioning aspects.

CONCLUSION:

The NRC plans to send a letter to the licensee which will document NRC's Request for Additional Information (RAI). The RAI's will address potential deficiencies in the licensee's Decommissioning Plan and request additional information to support license termination.

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
