SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Dr. O'Leary:

In facsimile dated November 29, 2012, you contacted the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 24-32416-01 for Scott Radiological Group, Inc. The aforementioned fax included NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," supporting the decommissioning of your location at 1420 Highway 61 South, Festus, Missouri. On January 4, 2013, I spoke with your authorized medical physicist, Dr. David Keys by telephone and he confirmed the HDR units used by Scott Radiological were in the possession of Midwest Brachytherapy Services, Inc. He also provided a copy of the leak test report for the source last used at your facility.


The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 1420 Highway 61 South, Festus, Missouri, is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 24-32416-01 is hereby terminated.
