SUMMARY The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) contacted Private Fuel Storage (PFS) to make them aware that a new fee rule will be issued soon that may allow PFS to be considered a small entity which would potential result in a greatly reduced annual license fee. PFS was informed that they would need to submit an application to be considered a small entity and the NRC would review the application to determine if PFS qualified for a small entity status. (Since it had taken a considerable amount of effort and resources to license the PFS storage facility, the NRC thought it prudent to notify PFS of this option in light of the decision by the Department of Energy to site an Interim Storage Facility). PFS was told that if they wished to proceed with the license termination, the NRC will proceed as quickly as possible to process their request. PFS was also told that if they choose to keep the license, they would have an outstanding balance, to date, of \$59,149.00 which would include principal and late charges for all quarterly fees issued through January 2013. They were also informed that another invoice in the amount of \$52,750 would be generated in April 2013. (PFS had paid their previous fees.) PFS stated that a board meeting would be held on February 8th and that the proposed fee rule would be discussed at that time and that they would notify the NRC of their intentions soon after.
