<u>ORDER</u>

(Establishing Revised Schedule for Hearing on Contention FC-1)

On December 21, 2012, Applicant Nuclear Innovation North America, LLC filed a Motion to Proceed with a Hearing on Contention FC-1.¹ Intervenors and the NRC Staff opposed the

motion, partially on the grounds that the NRC Staff had not yet completed its review of the

foreign ownership, control and domination (FOCD) issues that are the subject of Contention FC-

1.² We placed the motion in abeyance in light of the pending issuance by the NRC Staff of a

schedule for completion of its FOCD review.³ We directed the Applicant to supplement its

motion within ten days of the release of the NRC Staff's schedule.

On January 28, 2013, the NRC Staff submitted its schedule, and declared its intention to complete its FOCD review by April 2013 at the latest.⁴ On February 7, 2013, the Applicant filed a Supplement to its Motion to Proceed with a Hearing on Contention FC-1,⁵ superseding the original motion and proposing that the Board establish April 30, 2013 as the "trigger date" for proceeding to evidentiary hearing on Contention FC-1, in accordance with our Revised Scheduling Order.⁶ The Applicant states that no other party opposes its request to establish the trigger date.⁷

There being no objection, and in accordance with 10 C.F.R. 2.332(d), the Board finds that commencing the evidentiary hearing on Contention FC-1 following the release of the NRC Staff's FOCD review would expedite the proceeding. Accordingly, the Board establishes the trigger date as the earlier of (1) April 30, 2013, or (2) the date on which the NRC Staff makes publicly available its FOCD review.

It is so ORDERED.
