Barbara Boxer and Congressman Ed Markey have made public claims about the actions of Southern California Edison and Mitsubishi Heavy Industries in relation to the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, which has been out of service for over a year due to steam generator tube degradation. In order for the public to have the proper context to evaluate those claims, it is important that the media and the public have the opportunity to view the report in its entirety.

I have written extensively about the steam generator tube issues at SONGS over the past year and have read hundreds of pages of technical documents related to the issues, inspections and restart plan.
