The purpose of this modification is to revise travel arrangement number 29 to Cairo Egypt, previously authorized under contract modification number 35 by:

- (1) Change travel venue location: From Cairo, Egypt to Tunis, Tunisia.
- (2) Revising the travel dates From: December 8, 2012 – December 14, 2012
To: February 16, 2013 – February 22, 2013;
- (3) Revise the participants attendance list by deleting the names of some participants on the list and adding the names of some participants to the list and
- (4) as a result, revise the estimated total travel cost for 15 travelers to \$37,892.80 which includes airfare of \$17,950.30, lodging of \$9,540.00, meals, incidental expenses of \$9,652.50. TConneX was reimbursed \$8,135.60 for previous airline bookings. Thereby, the total amount not to exceed is reduced by \$8,135.60 from \$37,892.80 to \$29,757.20;

Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

Page 2 through 7 of modification number 35 is deleted entirely and the following is substituted in- lieu thereof:

Travel Arrangement (TA) 29 (Revised):

Travel Arrangement 29 (Revised: Travel to Tunis, Tunisia for 15 persons to attend "Nuclear Power Plant Sitings." The conference will be held in Tunis, Tunisia from Saturday, February 16, 2013 through Friday, February 22, 2013. For arrival in Tunis, Tunisia, travelers should arrive no later than Friday, February 15, 2013. Departure from Cairo, Egypt, travelers should depart no sooner than Saturday, February 23, 2013. Amount not to exceed \$29,757.20.

1.0 Scope of Work

The contractor is requested to make travel arrangements (including airfare, hotel, transportation [metro/taxi] and M&IE) to support the attendance of 15 persons traveling to Tunis, Tunisia as follows:

- Three (3) travelers from Cairo
- Two (2) travelers from Kuwait
- Two (2) travelers from Algeria
- Two (2) travelers from Sudan
- Two (2) travelers from Libya
- Two (2) travelers from Iraq
- Two (1) travelers from Jordan
- One (1) traveler from Lebanon

The purpose of this trip is to attend an NRC-sponsored conference on "Nuclear Power Plant Sitings." The conference will be held from Saturday, February 16, 2013 through Friday, February 22, 2013.

For arrival in Tunis, Tunisia, travelers should arrive no later than Friday, February 15, 2013.

Departure from Tunis, Tunisia, travelers should depart no sooner than Saturday, February 23, 2013.

All work shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of Contract NRC-08-10-302.

2.0 Reporting Requirements

The contractor shall follow all reporting requirements outlined in Contract NRC-08-10-302. There are no additional or special reporting requirements imposed by this Travel Arrangement.

3.0 Period and Place of Performance

Work shall be conducted at the contractor's facilities and should commence upon receipt of this Travel Arrangement.

4.0 Applicable Special Provisions

All work shall be conducted consisted with Contract NRC-08-10-302.

5.0 Technical Skills Required

6.0 Estimated Reimbursable Cost

The estimated total travel cost for 15 travelers is \$37,892.80 which includes airfare of \$17,950.30, lodging of \$9,540.00, meals, and incidental expenses of \$9,652.50. This amount of \$37,892.80 less previous reimbursement of airline bookings \$8,135.60 shall not exceed \$29,757.20.
