2/6/13 (16:40) Mr. McNamee attempted to contact me but I was out of the office. 2/7/2013 (09:00) I contacted Mr. McNamee to determine what type of information he required. Mr. McNamee stated that he was doing the work for the RSO preparing the license for termination and wanted to know what the NRC required. I helped Mr. McNamee download NRC Form 314, and stated that their letter should state what isotopes were used at the facility, in what rooms, when they were last used, and how they were disposed as well as surveys and waste records. I informed Mr. McNamee that the license had authorized phosphorus-32 and iodine-125 in the past and the 2011 inspection report indicated that the last use of licensed material was in March of 2004. I noted the change in phone number and asked Mr. McNamee if the licensee had moved. Mr. McNamee stated that the company had moved, were no longer conducting business at the previous address, and were located at 1 Jacks Hill Road, Oxford, CT. I stated that I would inform my supervisor of the change of location and would get back to him about what the NRC would require of the licensee. (09:45) I informed Mr. McNamee that my supervisor wanted him to describe the role he is taking on behalf of the RSO, when the licensee moved from the location of use in Seymour, CT, and when the decision was made not to continue licensed activities. Mr. McNamee stated that his role was to help the RSO gather the documents necessary for the pending termination of the license. The RSO is Thomas Soriano who is the President and CEO of the company and who retains all other responsibilities of the RSO. The licensee moved from the Seymour facility on September 1, 2012. Mr. McNamee stated that the licensee determined that it would not continue licensed operations on December 29, 2012. I informed Mr. McNamee that the NRC would be issuing a Notice of Violation for changing the location of the business without notifying the NRC and releasing the building for unrestricted use without prior approval from the Commission. I also stated that the licensee should submit a request to terminate the license as soon as possible but before February 27, 2013. The licensee was also informed that a representative should contact NRC HQ Fees Branch to resolve Invoice No. LFB-13-0103. Failure to pay the fee, which is assessed at the conclusion of each year of possession of the license, would result in the transfer of the debt to the Department of the Treasury who would make efforts to collect the fee. If there were any questions, I could be contacted.
