2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 8 x 30B Enriched UF6 Cylinders in sealed overpacks on 2 x 20' flatrack. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE, FISSILE. Total net weight of U is 12,084.2 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 571.941 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The ocean transportation from Port of Norfolk, VA to Gothenburg, Sweden will be the responsibility of Atlantic Container Line. The inland transportation from Columbia, SC to the Port of Norfolk, VA will be the responsibility of Westinghouse Electric Corporation. Export from the United States will occur at Norfolk, VA on or about October 19, 2012.


