LQD is in receipt of the well completion documentation received under cover of your letter dated January 24th, 2013 and subsequently updated January 29th, 2013 regarding Notice of Completion for Class III wells in Mine Unit 10B, Module 10-3. The Land Quality Division accepts your certification of the proper construction of these wells in compliance with your approved mine plan and Land Quality Division Non-Coal Rules and Regulations, Chapter 11, Section 11(b).

Please be advised that the Division will not exercise its right to inspect these wells as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 11(b)(ii)(A) and (B).

Uranium One may commence initial circulation operations with the wells located in Mine Unit 10B, Module 10-3, as per the 478 permit to mine. Please note the Mine unit 10B well data package is under final review following minor revisions received on the January 5th. I expect to recommend approval of the MU10B well data package shortly.

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
