This email is to document that verbal notification was given to your office on 2-18-13 of a reportable release on Permit 603, NRC Source Material License SUA-1548. The release happened on Sunday, 2-17-13. The data reported was as follows;

- Location: Wellfield F, bell hole F-42 near header house F-15.
- Fluid release estimated at 105 gallons of production fluid that entered a dry draw, Uranium content @ 5.7 ppm
- Cause was a hole in a poly-pipe. A vacuum truck was dispatched and recovered approximately 50 gallons of fluid released on the surface.

The WDEQ-WQD was contacted and a report will be filed with the WQD spill database.

A written notification will be sent out on or before Friday, February 22, 2013.
