Dear Mr. Leyse,

I am writing in regards to your letter dated February 28, 2012, by which you submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a petition for rulemaking (PRM). You requested that the NRC require all holders of operating licenses for nuclear power plants (NPPs) to operate NPPs with in-core thermocouples at different elevations and radial positions throughout the reactor core.

The petition was docketed as PRM 50-105, and a Notice of Receipt and request for public comment on PRM 50-93 was published in the *Federal Register* on May 23, 2012 (77FR30435). The public comment period closed on August 6, 2012. The NRC received four comment submissions (including your submissions). These comment submissions are posted online at www.regulations.gov (ID: NRC 2012-0056).

The NRC staff is currently reviewing your PRM. Once the PRM has been fully and formally resolved, a subsequent notice will be published in the *Federal Register*. You will also receive a letter at that time reiterating the outcome.
