Request to Amend the Price-Anderson Indemnities and Notification of a Name Change to Documents of Regulatory Interest

By letter dated October 2, 2012 (Accession No. ML12221A413), the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued amendments to the above operating licenses to change the name of an owner licensee from "FirstEnergy Nuclear Generation Corp." to "FirstEnergy Nuclear Generation, LLC" (FENGen LLC).

FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) requests that the NRC amend the Price-Anderson indemnities issued for the above licenses, pursuant to 10 CFR 140.20, to reflect the new name of "FirstEnergy Nuclear Generation, LLC" by January 30, 2014.

FENOC will amend the following documents, of regulatory interest to the NRC, to reflect the name change:

1. Support Agreement between FirstEnergy Corp. and FirstEnergy Nuclear Generation Corp. for financial assurance of the subsidiary dated December 16, 2005. A copy of this agreement was submitted by FENOC letter dated February 22, 2006 (Accession No. ML060620521). Section 4 of this agreement provides that 30 days prior written notice to the NRC must be given for any amendments or modifications.

2. Nuclear Decommissioning Master Trust Agreement dated December 1, 2005. A copy of this agreement was submitted by FENOC letter dated December 8, 2005 (Accession No. ML053500111). Article V of this agreement requires 30 working days prior notice to the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) for any material modifications. Notice is provided by copy of this letter to the Director, NRR.
3. FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company Master Nuclear Operating Agreement dated December 16, 2005. License Conditions 2.B.(7)(b) of the Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit No. 2 (BVPS) and the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit No. 1 (PNPP) operating licenses require as follows:

Further, the licensees are also required to notify the NRC in writing prior to any change in: (i) the terms or conditions of any lease agreements executed as part of these transactions; (ii) the [BVPS] [PNPP] Operating Agreement; (iii) the existing property insurance coverage for [BVPS Unit 2] [PNPP Unit 1]; and (iv) any action by a lessor or others that may have an adverse effect on the safe operation of the facility.

Notification is provided by this letter.
