Dear Sir or Madam:

On October 19, 2012 Global Nuclear Fuel – Americas L.L.C. (GNF-A) submitted an amended 30 day written report (Reference 4) in response to Event Notification 48202. The immediate and short-term corrective actions and five of the six longer term preventive actions have been completed for this event.

The remaining longer term preventive action is to evaluate opportunities to improve densitometer scrap handling and implement changes accordingly with a scheduled completion date of February 22, 2013. This evaluation is taking longer than anticipated. As a result, GNF-A is submitting a revised scheduled completion date as shown.


