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2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 5 x 20' containers loaded with 3,986 x Gd UO₂ rods packed into 27 x Traveller packages, USA/9297/AF-96 Rev 3. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, Type A Package, Fissile. Total net weight of U is 7,344 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 351 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The ocean transportation from Gothenburg, Sweden to the Port of Norfolk, VA will be the responsibility of Atlantic Container Line. The inland transportation from Norfolk, VA to Columbia, SC will be the responsibility of Westinghouse Electric Corporation.


