SUBJECT: SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT OF THE PHYSICAL SECURITY
PLAN FOR THE DECOMMISSIONING OF WESTINGHOUSE
HEMATITE DECOMMISSIONING PLAN

The Materials and Waste Security Branch in the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response has reviewed two Physical Security Plans, including the Security Category I Contingency Plans, for the decommissioning of the Hematite facility in Festus, Missouri. This activity was requested by the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (TAC JOO445). Our review focused on the appropriateness of the July and October 2012, revisions to the Physical Security Plan to inform a proposed modification to License Condition 13 of the Hematite license. We have determined that the Physical Security Plans and the Security Category I Contingency Plans meet the physical security requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 73.

Enclosed is the Safety Evaluation Report. The Safety Evaluation Report contains Safeguards Information and must be handled in accordance with Management Directive 12.7. The Safety Evaluation Report has been placed into the Safeguards Information Local Area Network and Electronic Safe.
