We understand that you intend to transfer your radiopharmacy operations from 9 Krupp Drive, Williston VT to 1191 S. Brownell Road, Suite 30, Williston VT. Please assure that the facility at 9 Krupp Drive is decommissioned and released for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 30.36 and the appropriate documentation is submitted to our office in accordance with 10 CFR 30.36(j). Until you have decommissioned the 9 Krupp Drive facility and it is removed from your license, you are still responsible for controlling access to the facility.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
