Your amendment request for a change of address was assigned to me. I will need to receive a copy of your amended Texas "possession and use" license before I can issue the amendment to your NRC exempt-distribution license. When I have received the amended Texas license, I will add your new address as a new distribution location, and change your mailing address.
