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LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

10 CFR 74.15 requires, in part, that each licensee who transfers special nuclear material shall complete and submit a Nuclear Material Transaction Report no later than the close of the next business day. Contrary to the above, as of February 6, 2013, the licensee did not submit the Nuclear Material Transaction Report for material transferred on July 25, 2012, a period in excess of the next business day. This is a Severity Level IV violation (Section 6.9).

Statement of Corrective Actions

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved). 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


