Enclosed is an application, dated February 25, 2013, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Y-12 National Security Complex, requesting amendment No. 01 to its existing license, XSNM3708. The license presently authorizes the licensee to export highly-enriched uranium to the Netherlands for use as targets to produce Mo-99 medical isotopes.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) add Maria Reactor in Poland and Covidien Isotope Production Facility in the Netherlands to "Intermediate Foreign Consignee(s)"; and 2) extend the expiration date from March 31, 2013 to December 31, 2013.

Before taking action on this request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the requested export meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.
