SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JANUARY 31, 2013, PUBLIC MEETING TO
DISCUSS UPCOMING PHASE 1 STAFFING SUBMITTALS
RELATED TO ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH NEAR-TERM TASK
FORCE RECOMMENDATION 9.3

On January 31, 2013, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a public meeting¹ with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) and industry representatives to discuss the upcoming Phase 1 staffing submittals addressing the recommendations in the *Near-Term Task Force (NTTF) Recommendations for Enhancing Reactor Safety in the 21st Century* report, issued July 12, 2011.² The meeting was focused on forthcoming submittals to the request for information regarding emergency preparedness phase 1 staffing assessments on or around April 30, 2013. Public participation was invited via meeting attendance, telephone conference and Web-based seminar.

The meeting participants are included in the enclosure to this document.

The NRC staff used a webinar format to present issues relating to the expectations of the forthcoming phase 1 staffing submittals. The presentation slides can be found under Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML13063A024. During the presentation, the staff discussed the use of security guards during a beyond design basis event. NEI provided discussion related to evaluations needed for individuals that don't have a direct role to assist and still return back to their duties during a beyond design basis.

The staff agreed to internally discuss and determine the appropriate regulatory action for the use of security personnel during a beyond design basis event. The meeting concluded with some questions and comments from stakeholders. The staff stated that a subsequent public
