Per Reference 1, Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse) is required to submit an effluent monitoring report for the Hematite Decommissioning Project (HDP) to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) within 60 days of January 1 of each year.

The reason for this request is a delay in receiving our analytical data from the contract laboratory, in part due to a severe ice/snow storm.
