SUBJECT: Joint Memorandum on Financial Fields Required for Investigations Processing

The Department of the Treasury announced that effective June 2013, the business rules for processing bulk invoices through the government's Central Accounting and Reporting System (CARS) via Intra-Governmental Payment and Collection (IPAC) must include the Treasury Account Symbol (TAS) and Business Event Type Code (BETC) in the format specified by the Treasury's Financial Management Service (FMS). In support of these requirements, the Office of Personnel Management's Chief Financial Officer and the Federal Investigative Services (FIS) have issued this joint memorandum to inform stakeholders of this mandate and to share long-term and interim solutions for including this information on all investigative invoices.

At this time, the Standard Form (SF) 86 is the only investigative form that includes fields in the Agency Use Block (AUB) for providing the TAS and BETC. FIS will amend the remaining investigation forms to make the TAS and BETC fields available in the future.

Until the investigation forms are updated, FIS has developed an interim solution to display the required information on all investigative invoices. The interim solution uses a table in the Personnel Investigation Processing System (PIPS) to identify the TAS, BETC, and, if provided, the Obligating Document Number based on the combination of the Submitting Office Number (SON), Security Office Identifier (SOI), and Agency Location Code (ALC) already required for each investigative request. The TAS/BETC information provided on the SF 86 will be used in lieu of information in the PIPS table; the PIPS table will only populate this information if the TAS/BETC fields are not provided.

In order to implement the interim solution, FIS must collect appropriate financial data to populate the PIPS table. There are two options to provide this information: 1) Submit the PDF-fillable version of the questionnaire. One questionnaire must be completed for each SON/SOI/ALC combination. 2) Submit the Excel version of the questionnaire. One line must be completed for each SON/SOI/ALC combination, but multiple combinations can be submitted

on a single spreadsheet. (The latter version is not recommended for printing.) Please choose the option that best suits your agency and return the information to FIS no later than Friday, March 29, 2013.

Until the long-term solution is implemented, we recommend that stakeholders maintain a copy of the completed questionnaire(s) to facilitate updates as needed.

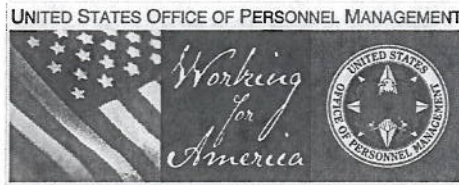
