Subject: Special Meeting June 13, 2007 Mandatory Industry Attendance Requested

The industry recently has been advised of a potential cyber security issue that can impact plant operations. Resolving this issue requires an organized response to implement mitigation measures.

The leadership of the Nuclear Sector Coordinating Council has reviewed the mitigation measures developed for this issue. The full Nuclear Sector Coordinating Council will be briefed on this situation at the June 7, 2007 meeting. The Nuclear Strategic Issues Advisory Steering Committee will be briefed at the June 20, 2007 meeting.

In order to move forward to implement the mitigation measures across the industry, NEI will be providing a special industry briefing on this issue and the mitigation measures on June 13, 2007 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. We will hold this meeting at in the Washington, DC area and will provide the details of the meeting location later. The meeting will be held at the Official Use Only level and will not contain safeguards information. We consider attendance at this meeting to be mandatory.

You are requested to send no more than three representatives from your company to receive the briefing. We request your representatives be senior members of your staff with knowledge of plant engineering and operations.
