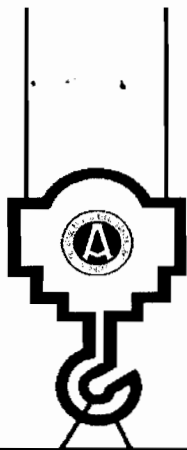

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**SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO APPARENT VIOLATION IN INSPECTION REPORT NO. 03029427/2012001, EA-13-017**

Violation #1: Failure to use two independent controls to secure portable gauges from unauthorized removal.

Reason for the apparent violation: Lock had been removed from the gauges storage cabinet, and the locks had been removed from gauges storage boxes.

Corrective action taken: Purchased new locks and installed the locks on the storage cabinet and the gauges storage boxes.

Corrective action to avoid further violations: Gauges were transferred to Cline's Technical Services (license no. 03225230000) on Nov. 1, 2012. We have asked the NRC to terminate our license.

Violation #2: Did not review the radiation protection program content and implementation.

Corrective action to avoid further violations: Transferred gauges to Cline's Technical Services and requested the NRC to terminate our license.

Violation #3: Did not conduct a physical inventory every 6 months.

Corrective action to avoid further violations: Transferred gauges to Cline's Technical Services and requested the NRC to terminate our license.

Violation #4: Did not maintain a log book.

Corrective action to avoid further violations: Transferred gauges to Cline's Technical Services and requested the NRC to terminate our license.

Savage Construction Company now realizes that it was not in compliance with NRC regulations, and so as not to incur further violations we have decided to terminate our program. Since the inspection took place on October 19,2012 we transferred our portable gauges to Cline's Technical Services on November 1,2012 and requested a license termination on November 13,2012. We understand the seriousness of the violations and that is why we have taken such quick action to get everything corrected.

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
