PURPOSE: The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received a license
renewal application (LRA) from Tennessee Valley Authority dated
January 15, 2013, for the renewal of the operating license for the
Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. The purpose of these meetings
is to discuss the license renewal and environmental scoping process for
the LRA review. These meetings are being conducted as part of the
scoping process outlined in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*
Part 51 to support the development of an environmental impact
statement. These meetings will provide members of the public with the
opportunity to provide comments regarding environmental issues that the
NRC should consider during its review.
