OIP3 - Export and Import of Nuclear Material; Export of IAEA Safeguard Samples and Physical Security

This rule conforms 10 CFR Part 110 with the nuclear non-proliferation policy of the Executive Branch. This rule facilitates implementation of the Protocol Additional to the Agreement Between the United States of America and the International Atomic Energy Agency for the Application of Safeguards in the United States of America to expand the exemption from the requirements for a license to include exports of source and byproduct material in IAEA safeguards samples. This rule also amends 10 CFR 110.44 to incorporate by reference IAEA's INFCIRC/225/Revision 5, "Nuclear Security Recommendations on Physical Protection of Nuclear Material and Nuclear Facilities." Please note that due to a continuing internal debate at IAEA regarding INFCIRC/225/Rev. 5, the incorporation by reference of that document into 10 CFR Part 110 may be accomplished in a later rulemaking.

This rulemaking scores a 36 (20, 6, 10, 0) because:

- It is a direct contributor toward Security Goal 8.
- It is a moderate contributor to Openness and implements strategy 1.
- This rulemaking is mandated by U.S. foreign policy and multilateral obligations.
- This rulemaking has not garnered any public interest.
