ORDER

On July 6, 1994, General Atomics filed pursuant to 10 CFR 2.730, a Motion to Stay Discovery in this proceeding either (1) until the Commission has determined whether it will grant General Atomics' June 24, 1994 Petition for Review of LBP-94-17 and/or Motion for Directed Certification, or (2) assuming that the Commission grants the Petition, until the Commission has determined with finality the issues raised in General Atomics' February 17, 1994 Motion for Summary Disposition or for an Order of Dismissal.

In the interest of moving expeditiously on General Atomics' motion, I am exercising my authority under 10 C.F.R. § 2.772(a) to shorten the periods within which replies may be filed to the motion by staff and the other parties. Any replies to General Atomics' Motion to Stay Discovery must be filed in such a manner that ensures receipt by close of business (4:15 pm EDT) on Friday, July 15, 1994.




