SUBJECT: MARCH 11, 2013, CONFERENCE CALL SUMMARY TO
DISCUSS SEISMIC PROJECT STATUS, HONEYWELL
METROPOLIS WORKS (TAC NO. L32788)

On March 11, 2013, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of Honeywell Metropolis Works held a telephone conference. The purpose of the call was to discuss project status and the next steps on the review.

NRC staff and Honeywell discussed possible dates for future meetings. Tentative dates were presented for meetings involving Honeywell, NRC management and technical reviewers. More conversations need to occur before the exact dates can be set.

Honeywell stated that their bi-annual emergency response exercise will be held May 16, 2013. In addition, Honeywell will submit a new revision of their Safety Basis and Corrective Action Program. There will be no changes to the conclusions or analysis, just inclusion of additional information based on discussions regarding the request for additional information responses.

No staff decisions were made at this meeting.
