
RE: Request for source hazard determination

To whom it may concern:

City Hospital is currently in possession of an Au-195 calibration source that was calibrated for 1.0mCi on September 15, 1982. As the half-life of this source is 186.1 days, the source has been through approximately 59 half-lives. We would like to request that the NRC determine that this source presents no hazard to health or threat to the environment and allow for disposal in the regular trash under 10 CFR 20.2002. The source details can be found below.
