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Alan,

We haven't seen the final license yet so the following comments are based on the draft license.

We expect that the maximum flow rate described in the draft license will allow us to produce up to 1 million pounds per year from the wellfields at the Lost Creek Project. The draft license allows us to produce up to 2 million pounds of dried yellowcake. The additional 1 million pounds will likely come from a satellite facility that we would construct at Shirley Basin. Assuming we can load 6.5 pounds of yellowcake per cubic foot of resin and we want to ship 1 million pounds of yellowcake from the satellite each year, it will take about 154 shipments per year at 1,000 cubic feet per shipment.

The draft license doesn't specify where the uranium will come from so the above estimates will likely change some to reflect operational realities. However, this estimate is as accurate as I can get at this point in time.
