MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Scheduling Oral Argument)

After reviewing the recent filings by Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC), General Atomics (GA), and the NRC staff concerning SFC's December 2, 1994 motion for a protective order, the Board has concluded that it has additional questions concerning both the issue of the appropriate language for paragraph seven of the proposed order and the question of whether the staff need be a party to any such order. Accordingly, on Thursday, February 2, 1995, the Board will provide the parties with an opportunity to make a brief oral presentation in support of their positions on these issues and to answer Board questions regarding these matters.



This hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. in the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel Hearing Room, Room 3B45, Third Floor, Two White Flint North Building, 11545 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. Counsel for SFC and GA will be afforded the opportunity to make the initial presentation. Staff counsel will then have a chance to respond. Thereafter, SFC and GA counsel will be given time to present any rebuttal arguments. In addition, notwithstanding the fact they did not submit any filings relative to the proposed protective order, counsel for intervenors Native Americans for a Clean Environment (NACE) and the Cherokee Nation may make a brief oral statement regarding the proposed protective order at the conclusion of the staff's presentation.
