On February 3, 1995, Counsel for the NRC Staff received a facsimile copy of a "Stipulated Supplemental Motion for Protective Order," filed by General Atomics. The motion concerned the addition of a paragraph addressing Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests for material protected under the proposed Protective Order. The Staff did not have sufficient time to review the language proposed by General Atomics prior to close of business on that date. The Staff has now reviewed the language and the plans to propose certain changes to the language submitted. I have contacted counsel for General Atomics in an effort to resolve any differences we have regarding the language of the proposed paragraph.

The Staff would therefore request that the Board defer any action regarding the proposed paragraph until the parties have had an opportunity to resolve any differences.
