Discussions will include the status of rulemaking to Part 21 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, "Reporting of Defects and Noncompliance;" Revision 2 to NUREG-1520, "Standard Review Plan for the Review of License Application for a Fuel Cycle Facility;" draft NUREG-2154, "Corrective Action Programs for Fuel Cycle Facilities;" and cumulative effects of regulations.
