(Requesting Party Filings on
Motion for Protective Order)

Upon consideration of the December 2, 1994 motion for protective order filed by licensee Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC), it is

ORDERED, that on or before Friday, December 23, 1994, each party may file a pleading discussing any administrative or judicial precedent supporting its position concerning the appropriate language for paragraph seven of the proposed protective order. Responses to any party's pleading shall be filed on or before Friday, January 6, 1995.

In addition to regular service by mail on each Board member and the other participants, each party should send a copy of its initial pleading and any responsive filing to

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the Board and the other participants by facsimile transmission or other means that will ensure receipt by 4:30 p.m. EST on the day of filing.
