Subject: Strengthen or Close GE Reactors

I understand that the NRC Commissioners soon will vote on whether or not to require filters and rupture discs designed to "work" on General Electric nuclear reactors during a severe accident.

These General Electric Mark I and Mark II reactors demonstrated their vulnerability to such accidents at Fukushima in March 2011.

These GE reactors suffer from SERIOUS fundamental design deficiencies. They provide only a small amount of the nation's electricity. They should be immediately and permanently shut down.

We are talking about severe mutations happening to your very own descendants here! No one can withstand high levels of radiation. More accidents WILL happen: there are earthquakes, tidal waves, other natural disasters that are bound to occur, PLUS there is always the possibility of human error or human malice.

We are talking about the survival of the human race (not to mention that of innocent animals).

Nearly two years after Fukushima, the NRC has done nothing to enhance the safety of the GE reactors. In a severe accident the amount of radioactivity released offsite from an unfiltered vent would be very large and damaging. It makes no sense not to add a filter to protect our families and property from contamination. Filtered systems are available, tested and in use today - for example in Sweden, Germany, France, Switzerland - and will be installed in Japan.

Radiation from Fukushima is all through the Pacific Ocean and all across the entire United States. Even milk in Vermont has been affected. Do you understand? Does this have any meaning to you at all?

As part of the Fukushima Lessons Learned Task Force, the NRC Staff recommended such filtering. But the nuclear industry has been lobbying against this measure, concerned more with the size of its bank accounts than public safety. HOW can we allow this?!!

I demand that the NRC Commissioners to act to permanently close these dangerous reactors immediately. Until they have all been shut down, the Commissioners must require installation of filtered vent systems.

PLEASE. Use your brains, and your hearts. This must end.
