WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE FOR TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY COMMITMENT RELATED TO CORE PLATE BOLT STRESS ANALYSIS (TAC NOS. ME6615, ME6616, AND

ME6617)

Dear Mr. Shea:

By letter dated October 25, 2012, you submitted an affidavit dated October 8, 2012, executed by Edward D. Schrull of General Electric-Hitachi Nuclear Energy Americas LLC (GEH). It was requested that the information contained in NEDC-33779P, "RAI [Request for Additional Information] Response Support for Core Plate Hold Down Bolt Stress Analysis Performed to Address License Renewal Commitment for Tennessee Valley Authority [TVA] Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, Units 1, 2 and 3," Revision 1, dated October 2012 be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 2, Section 2.390.

A nonproprietary copy of this document has been placed in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Public Document Room and added to the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Public Electronic Reading Room.

The affidavits stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- a. Information that discloses a process, method, or apparatus, including supporting data and analyses, where prevention of its use by GEH's competitors without license from GEH constitutes a competitive economic advantage over GEH and/or other companies.
- Information that, if used by a competitor, would reduce their expenditure of resources or improve their competitive position in the design, manufacture, shipment, installation, assurance of quality, or licensing of a similar product.

By letter dated May 28, 2013, TVA provided clarification regarding the proprietary information in the Enclosure 1 of its letter dated October 25, 2012. TVA stated that the proprietary information in Enclosure 1 was extracted from Enclosure 3 that is the above GEH referenced document and its affidavit dated October 8, 2012, is provided in Enclosure 5 of the TVA letter dated October 25, 2012.

J. Shea - 2 -

The NRC staff has reviewed your submittals and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of the statements in the affidavit, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the versions of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.
