| 2/21/2013 PM John Miller spoke with Michael Russell and he asked Miller about the PharmaLogic operation at 9 Krupp Drive, Williston, VT. Mr. Russell stated that he was an attorney representing Bartlett Realty LLC who was the landlord of 9 Krupp Drive. He was interested in understanding the requirements for releasing the facility for unrestricted use. Miller stated that his understanding was that PharmaLogics was moving their operations to another facility in Williston and they planned to decommission the 9 Krupp Drive and request that the facility be released for unrestricted use and removed from their NRC license. Miller explained that the licensee would have to divest themselves of all radioactive material, survey the facility to demonstrate the facility did not have any residual radioactive contamination above releasable levels, and submit the surveys, and other documentation to the NRC with a request to remove the facility from their license. Mr. Russell asked Miller if he could recommend a consultant that could review PharmaLogics performance and make some independent measurements after they have left the facility. Miller stated that he was not at liberty to recommend a consultant but he recommended that Mr. Russell contact the Health Physics Society and ask them to recommend a consultant in his area. Mr. Russell asked him if he could be notified when the facility was being released for unrestricted use and removed from the license. Miller stated that would be done. | | | | |
