 2/22/2013 AM John Miller spoke with Stephen Bartlett and he asked Miller about the PharmaLogic operation at 9 Krupp Drive, Williston, VT. He was interested in understanding the requirements for releasing the facility for unrestricted use. Miller stated that his understanding was that PharmaLogics was moving their operations to another facility in Williston and they planned to decommission the 9 Krupp Drive and request that the facility be released for unrestricted use and removed from their NRC license. Miller explained that the licensee would have to divest themselves of all radioactive material, survey the facility to demonstrate the facility did not have any residual radioactive contamination above releasable levels, and submit the surveys, and other documentation to the NRC with a request to remove the facility from their license. Miller informed Mr. Bartlett that he should not lease that space to a new tenant until the NRC releases that site from their license. Miller added that PharmaLogic was required to control access to that area until it is released for unrestricted use and removed from the inderstood. He requested that he be notified when the facility was being released for unrestricted use and removed from the license. Miller stated that would be done. 			
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
