SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF CATEGORY 2 PUBLIC MEETING: DISCUSSION OF

THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION TITLE 10 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS PART 52 SELF-ASSESSMENT

WORKING GROUP WITH INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVES

On March 28, 2013, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff, Office of New Reactors (NRO), held a public meeting to discuss with industry representatives the charter of the Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulation* (10 CFR) Part 52 Self-Assessment Working Group and to solicit feedback from the Part 52 licensees on opportunities to refine NRC processes associated with 10 CFR Part 52.

The NRC 10 CFR Part 52 Self-Assessment Working Group was established to identify lessons learned associated with NRC activities during the period since the first combined operating license was granted to Vogtle units 3 and 4 in early 2012. Representatives from Southern Nuclear Company, South Carolina Electric and Gas, and the Nuclear Energy Institute presented several topics of interest.
