The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted environmental scoping meetings related to the review of the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant (SQN) license renewal applications submitted by Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). Two public meetings were conducted on April 3, 2013, at the Soddy Daisy City Hall in Soddy Daisy, TN. Approximately 80 people attended the meetings. The attendees included members of the NRC staff, members of the public, representatives from TVA, news media, and local government officials. Public comments and questions were mainly focused on the concerns regarding emergency preparedness, aging management, design safety, human health and radiological exposure, environmental impacts, radioactive waste storage and disposal, flooding, seismic, and other Fukushima type accidents.
