On March 12, 2012, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Reference 1 to all power reactor licensees and holders of construction permits in active or deferred status. Enclosure 1 of Reference 1 contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information, and Required Responses associated with Recommendation 2.1 concerning seismic hazards reevaluation. Reference 1 requires

that within 60 days of the date of the NRC's issuance of guidance on screening and prioritization criteria, and the implementation details of the risk assessment, each addressee submit: (1) its intention to follow the NRC-developed guidance, or (2) an alternative approach, including acceptance criteria. In accordance with References 1 and 2, the 60-day responses are due to the NRC by April 29, 2013.

Pursuant to Reference 1, please be advised that Ameren Missouri intends to respond to Enclosure 1 of Reference 1 by following the approach described in Reference 3, on the schedule provided in Reference 3. In regard to this approach, this letter contains a new commitment which is identified in the attached List of Commitments.
