## General Comment

I live in Oceanside, just 10 miles away from the dangerous San Onofre nuclear reactors. Please do not re-open them, even partially.

- The San Onofre facilities – except for turbines -- are old, run down and unpredictable
- A very large earthquake is overdue -- Now that we've seen what earthquakes can do, in Fukushima, we are very afraid they pose an imminent hazard.
- A radiation leak would probably cause gridlock on our highways and public panic.

Yesterday the Los Angeles City Council joined other SoCal cities by voting unanimously to ask the NRC not to allow the restart of the crippled San Onofre nuclear reactors before the formal public hearings.
