MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE MEDICAL USES OF ISOTOPES

April 15-16, 2013

MEETING SUMMARY

PURPOSE

To discuss current rulemaking activities and other issues related to the implementation of the medical regulations in Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 35, and "Medical Use of Byproduct Material."

OUTCOME

The Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI) made recommendations, and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff gained a better understanding of the views and opinions of the ACMUI, as well as other stakeholders' views and opinions. The staff will consider these views in its continuing effort to make 10 CFR Part 35 more useful, practical, and not overly burdensome on licensees, while maintaining public health and safety.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND ACTIONS

For agenda topic 3, Biennial Evaluations and Discussion, the ACMUI recommended tabling the amendments to the ACMUI Bylaws to the fall 2013 ACMUI meeting. The recommendation passed unanimously with twelve favorable votes.

For agenda topics 4 and 5, Opening Statements and Special Presentation, NRC Chairman Allison Macfarlane made a special presentation to Dr. Malmud to thank him for his eleven years of service and leadership to the ACMUI. Brian McDermott, Director of the Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, announced Dr. Bruce Thomadsen as the new ACMUI Chair and Dr. Milton Guiberteau as the new ACMUI Vice Chair.

For agenda topic 8, Draft Guidance for 10 CFR Part 35 Rulemaking, Dr. Langhorst requested if NRC staff could add the Draft Guidance for the Draft Expanded Part 35 Rulemaking into the same docket number as the Rulemaking document. If this is not possible, she requests that the location (docket number) of the draft guidance be clearly identified in the Draft Expanded Part 35 Rulemaking docket (and vice versa).

For agenda topic 9, Medical Related Events, the ACMUI scheduled a teleconference on June 18, 2013 from 2-4pm EDT to discuss the Medical Events Subcommittee analysis of yttrium-90 microspheres medical events. The back-up teleconference meeting date is June 20, 2013 from 2-4pm EDT.

For agenda topic 10, Abnormal Occurrence (AO) Subcommittee Report, the ACMUI endorsed the AO Criteria Subcommittee Report. The recommendation passed unanimously with twelve favorable votes.

For agenda topic 16, Thyroid Cancer Survivors' Conference, Dr. Guiberteau requested that NRC staff provide a link to the abstract cited in Ms. Weil's presentation to the full ACMUI.

For agenda topic 17, Germanium-68/Gallium-68 Generator, Clinical Uses and Regulatory Issues, the ACMUI recommended that NRC provide regulatory relief from the decommissioning funding plan requirements for the use of a Germanium-68/Gallium-68 generator. The recommendation passed with eight favorable votes and four abstentions.

For agenda topic 18, Administrative Closing, the ACMUI planned to hold the fall 2013 ACMUI Meeting on September 9-10, 2013 at NRC Headquarters. The back-up meeting date is September 16-17, 2013.
