SUMMARY

This refers to your application to renew your license dated October 26, 2012 and the phone conversation between John Thornton and Jennifer Bishop on March 19, 2013.

A. During our review of your renewal application dated April 25, 2012, it appeared that your application had not been completely prepared in accordance with the guidance in NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses, dated November 2001." This omission has resulted in an incomplete application that contains numerous restrictive elements which we believe you would find difficulty complying with, if we were to include them in your license.

RESPONSE: As we discussed, please resubmit your application in its entirety using the guidance in NUREG 1556, Volume 1.

- B. In addition, please note the following items need to be addressed in your application:
 - 1. The Seaman Nuclear gauges currently listed on your license were not a part of your license application. Also, the total possession limit for the devices you have

requested was not provided.

Your current license allows for the appointing of site RSO's, however this condition
was not requested and supporting documentation was not provided. While this
condition is not required for your program, if you would like to maintain this condition
please provide documents to support your program.

3. The application states that the course outline for the Authorized User training was attached; however these documents were not included as a part of the application. In addition, the instructor qualifications were not provided as a part of the application.

C. In your application, you requested an exemption from the condition for providing occupational dosimetry. The NRC does not approve exemptions for this condition, however please note that you can provide an evaluation showing that individuals will not receive 10 percent of their annual dose limits.
