I informed him: 1) Thrasher will need a license amendment if they want to add additional gauges to their license; 2) Thrasher will need a license amendment if they plan to move the gauges to a new storage location; 3) The storage method must meet the security requirements of 10 CFR 30.34(i); 4) Thrasher can consult NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, for additional guidance (e.g., Appendix I); 5) The Thrasher Radiation Safety Officer, Andrew Kincell, can provide additional guidance; and 6) Thrasher can contact Randy Ragland (610-337-5083) or Scott Wilson (610-337-5136) with additional questions. 7) Due to a potential significant increase in possession limits, this action would likely prompt an inspection by NRC Region I.
